### AWARDS CATEGORIES AND ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

#### 1. ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

##### A. Academic Honors Award

- a. **Elementary:** A student must have as a minimum three (3) 'A' grade and one (1) 'B' grade in the four (4) core subjects (Language Arts, Social Studies, Mathematics, Science)
- b. **Junior High:** A student must receive as a minimum **80%** in three of the core subjects and **70%** in the other core subject, with an 80% average in the four core subjects.
- c. **Senior High:** A student must receive an 'honors' standing in the academic year.
- d. **Post Secondary:** A student in University, Technical Institution, or Junior College should receive a grade point average of 7.5 (out of 9) or an average of **80%**.

*No application for Kindergarten will be accepted*

##### B. Academic Excellence Award

Graduating students of Junior High, Senior High, and Post Secondary Institutions, who have maintained an honors standing in each of the academic years during the period of their certificate, diploma, or degree program are eligible for this award.

*In the academic achievements, only one award will be given.*

#### 2. DISTINCTIVE ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

A student who has won distinction (1, 2 or 3 prize) in Music, Drama, Debating, Mathematics, Science, Arts, Cultural, Athletics, or any other extracurricular field is eligible. The distinction must have been won in an open competition and must be at the municipal, provincial, or national level. Regular graduation from an institution or the obtaining of a high grade in it self, in any one of these fields will not be considered sufficient for this award.

#### 3. NATIONAL INDO CANADIAN COUNCIL (NICC) EXEMPLARY CITIZENSHIP AWARD

A student of Junior High, Senior High, or Post Secondary Institution who has i) displayed good citizenship, ii) done exemplary community services and iii) obtained an average of at least 70% on the four (4) core subjects, are eligible. The details of the community service and citizenship demonstrated, duly supported by testimonials from recipient institutions and other should accompany the application.
